4. Except for baked goods, NO EXHIBIT MAY BE REMOVED BEFORE 7 PM, SATURDAY. We are not responsible for anything left after 9 p.m. Saturday.
5. The society is not responsible for any loss but takes every precaution to prevent any loss or damage to the goods. All entries must not have been exhibited at any previous Adams County Fair.
6. Exhibitors will be responsible for correct placing of entry tags onto items. If item is tagged wrong, the entry will be disqualified.
