IMPORTANT RULES

- Entries are only open to Adams County residents.
- Adams County Agricultural Society is not responsible for loss or damage.
- Participants can compete in all divisions but limited to one entry per class maximum of 5 entries per department per exhibitor.
 - Participants are responsible for labeling entries with correct entry tags.
 - Incorrectly labeled items will be disqualified.
- No items shall be removed from the Floral Hall before 7PM Saturday July 18th.

DEPARTMENT SPECIFIC RULES

FLOWERS

- One entry per class. Entries must be pre-registered, correctly tagged by the exhibitor, and in place by specified time.
- Flowers must be grown by exhibitor.
- Foliage should be retained on specimens. Specimens should be de-budded but show no evidence of recent re-budding.
- Houseplants must be in the possession of the exhibitor and not show any evidence of recent repotting.

FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS

- One entry per class. Entries must be pre-registered, correctly tagged by the exhibitor, and in place by specified time.
- All entries are to be artistic arrangements as known to flower designers and must be the work of the exhibitor. No Scenes.
- Any class of foliage is permitted. Accessories are permitted in all classes.
- Greenhouse or artificial materials may be used but should be kept to a minimum.

PHOTOGRAPHY

- Limit one entry per class, maximum of 5 entries per exhibitor. All entries must be the work of exhibitor.
- Amateur photographers only.
- All photos are to be displayed in a solid black plastic frame no larger than 5x7 inches and must be able to sit on a shelf.
- **NO GLASS FRAMES WILL BE ACCEPTED!**
- Subject matter is at the discretion of the Floral Hall Committee. No digital alterations or dates permitted on photos.

ALL DEPARTMENTS

- For all departments, the exhibits presented must be the work of the exhibitor. One entry per class and a maximum of 5 entries per department per exhibitor.
